Study Restrictions Include

- No use of prescription or nonprescription drugs, vitamins and dietary supplements, within 14 days or 5 half-lives (whichever is longer) prior to day 1 of the study and for the entire duration of the study.
- Herbal supplements must be discontinued for 30 days prior to the start of the study and for the entire duration of the study.
- No alcohol consumption is allowed 48 hours prior to admit or each visit.
- Must not drink more than 2 standard drinks of alcohol per day throughout the duration of the study
- You must fast for 10 hours prior to each outpatient visit: no consumption of food or beverages except water
- Must take appropriate precautions to prevent pregnancy until the completion of the study
- You should maintain your current regimen of diet and exercise. You will be required to refrain from intensive exercise (e.g. heavy lifting or long runs) 48 hours prior to each visit.
